

ORDER 2011-174

**AN ORDER AFFIRMING THE REVOCATION OF
KEITH A. JORDAN'S OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE**

Mr. Keith A. Jordan was issued a permanent occupational license on April 14, 2010, which was renewed in 2011. On March 11, 2011, Mr. Jordan pleaded guilty to Possession of a Scheduled II Controlled Substance, a D-Felony. In order to maintain suitability for licensure, an occupational license may not be convicted of a felony under the laws of the State of Indiana or the laws of any other state or jurisdiction.

On April 7, 2011, the Commission filed a disciplinary complaint seeking to revoke Mr. Jordan's occupational license due to his failure to maintain suitability. On June 1, 2011, the Commission filed a Motion for Summary Judgment. On July 1, 2011, a hearing was conducted on the Commission's Motion, with Mr. Jordan appearing. On July 1, 2011, the ALJ granted the Commission's Motion and issued an Order for Summary Judgment.

COMMISSION ACTION


After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

the Administrative Law Judge's Order. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.


