

ORDER 2012-173

**AN ORDER AFFIRMING THE CIVIL PENALTY AGAINST GEORGI
GEORGIEV FOR VIOLATION OF HIS PLACEMENT ON THE STATEWIDE
EXCLUSION LIST**

On August 24, 2010, Georgi Georgiev was placed on the Statewide Exclusion List, barring his presence on the gaming floor at any casino in Indiana. On July 15, 2011, Georgiev was found at the Hollywood Casino in Lawrenceburg, Indiana in violation of the terms of the placement on the Statewide Exclusion List. While in the gaming area of the Hollywood Casino, Georgiev possessed \$2,423 in winnings.

On October 6, 2011, the Commission staff initiated a civil penalty administrative action by filing a complaint against Georgiev in the amount of \$2,423 for being in violation of 68 IAC 6-1-4.5. Georgiev failed to file an Answer to the Commission's complaint. On October 29, 2012, the Administrative Law Judge issued a Default Judgment Order against Georgiev for failure to respond to the Commission staff's civil penalty administrative complaint.

COMMISSION ACTION


After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:
