

ORDER 2013-102

RATIFYING THE PREVIOUSLY ISSUED ORDER 2013-HO-06

Commission Resolution 2012-151 allows the Executive Director, upon obtaining consent from one Commissioner, to exercise the powers and duties of the Commission under IC 4-33-4-1.


The Commission has considered the following factors:

1. The Commission may take action, including, but not limited to, revocation, suspension, or restriction of an occupational license at any time that the Commission determines the occupational licensee is in violation of the IC 4-33 or 68 IAC 2. 68 IAC 4-33-8-11.
2. The Commission may suspend an occupational license without notice or an evidentiary proceeding, by an authorized individual or panel of individuals. 68 IAC 13-1-22.
3. On April 18th, Executive Director Yelton, upon obtaining concurrence from a Commissioner, issued Order 2013-HO-06, under Indiana Code 4-21.5-4, 68 IAC 13-1-22, and Resolution 2012-151.
4. Order 2013-HO-06 found that a current Level 3 licensee was unsuitable for licensure, and that it was in the best interests of the public and the gaming industry to suspend the Level 3 licensee's license immediately.
5. Resolution 2012-151 requires that the Executive Director must report any action taken under Resolution 2012-151 to the Commission for ratification or other action by the Commission.

Based on the foregoing, the Commission hereby **RATIFIES** the Executive Director's April 18th, 2013 order, 2013-HO-06.


