

ORDER 2013-192

**AN ORDER REGARDING THE APPEAL OF THE
VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #13-72**

On September 12, 2013, in Order 2013-127, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) approved remittance of \$1,422.50 against John Doe #13-72 for the reason that John Doe #13-72 was a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program at the time John Doe #13-72 won a jackpot for \$1,422.50 while in the gaming area of the Hoosier Park Casino in Anderson, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #13-72 timely filed with the Commission an appeal of Order 2013-127. On November 14, 2013, Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #13-72.

COMMISSION ACTION

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

APPROVES

the Settlement Agreement between Commission staff and John Doe #13-72. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.
