

**ORDER 2013-211**

**REGARDING THE COMMISSION'S CLAIM AGAINST  
FISTS WILL FLY, LLC'S SURETY BOND**

On August 23, 2013, the Commission issued promoter's license number MP000042 to Fists Will Fly, LLC ("Promoter"), under which it conducted a pro-am mixed martial arts event on August 24, 2013, in Evansville, Indiana. As required by IC 4-33-22-32(b) and 68 IAC 24-3-13, Promoter obtained a surety bond in the amount of \$10,000 conditioned upon the payment of all financial and tax obligations under IC 4-33-22-32.

Although some payments have been made, Promoter has failed to make all payments necessary under IC 4-33-22; 68 IAC 24-3-27; and 68 IAC 24-3-16. The Commission's records reflect that Promoter continues to owe the Commission a total amount of Four Thousand Eighty Eight Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$4,088.50) for unpaid reimbursement fees (Nine Hundred Nineteen Dollars, \$919.00), and unpaid ticket tax (Three Thousand One Hundred Sixty Nine Dollars and Fifty Cents, \$3,169.50), respectively. Under Section 5 of Resolution 2010-127, the recovery of required payments through the exercise of the promoter's bond must be approved by the Commission.

**COMMISSION ACTION**


After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-33-22 and 68 IAC 24, the Commission hereby finds that by failing to provide payment of the required financial and tax obligations as described above, Promoter has failed to perform part of its payment obligations and **APPROVES** the recovery of the required payments in the amount of \$4,088.50 through the exercise of the Promoter's bond.
