

ORDER 2015-134
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
IN RE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT OF THE APPEAL OF THE
VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #15-16

On March 19, 2015, in Order 2015-16, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") approved remittance of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) against John Doe #15-16 for the reason that John Doe #15-16 was a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program at the time John Doe #15-16 won cash equivalents while in the gaming area of the Horseshoe Hammond Casino in Hammond, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #15-16 timely filed with the Commission an appeal of Order 2015-16. Administrative Law Judge Michael Cook was assigned to the case. On August 28, 2015, Commission staff agreed to settle the appeal with John Doe #15-16. The settlement agreement was subsequently approved by the Administrative Law Judge.

After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

AFFIRMS


