

ORDER 2016-055
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH MONTE MILLER

Monte Miller ("Licensee") currently holds a Level 1 occupational license as a Controller at Rising Star Casino & Resort. On six separate occasions between June 2015 and October 2015, Licensee was observed by Commission Agents not wearing or properly displaying his identification badge as required of all license holders. On each of the six occasions, Licensee had the identification badge tucked into his front shirt pocket and failed to properly display it as required of all occupational license holders during work hours.


Pursuant to 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 2-3-5(f)(4)(B) the permanent identification badge must be worn by all occupational licensees and displayed clearly during work hours. The permanent identification badge remains, at all times, property of the Commission and may be revoked, suspended, cancelled, or restricted in accordance with 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 13.

In lieu of disciplinary proceedings, Commission staff and Licensee have agreed to settle this matter pursuant to 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 2-3-5(f)(2). The terms of the settlement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, provide that Licensee agrees to an unpaid voluntarily relinquishment of Licensee's occupational license and identification badge for a period of three regularly scheduled working days, without using vacation or any other paid leave time.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
