

ORDER 2016-127
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH
MICHAEL GUERRERO

Michael Guerrero ("Licensee") has held a Level 3 occupational license as a bar porter at Ameristar Casino since March 6, 2013. On February 1, 2016, Licensee submitted a three year reinvestigation/renewal application to the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission"). During the background reinvestigation, the Commission investigators determined that Licensee failed to disclose or update the Commission of one arrest, indictment, charge, or conviction as required by 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 2-3-9.


All occupational licensees have a continuing duty to maintain suitability for licensure and must notify the Commission of any changes in the information submitted in the licensee's application or any information that could render the licensee ineligible to hold an occupational license. 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 2-3-9. Further, all occupational licensees are under a continuing duty to advise the Commission if the occupational licensee has been arrested for, indicted of, charged with, convicted of, or plead guilty to any felony or misdemeanor offense within ten calendar days of the occurrence. 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 2-3-9.1.

In lieu of disciplinary proceedings, Commission staff and Licensee have agreed to settle this matter pursuant to 68 Ind. Admin. Code § 2-3-5(f)(2). The terms of the settlement have been reduced to writing, and in pertinent part, provide that Licensee agrees to an unpaid voluntarily relinquishment of Licensee's occupational license and identification badge for a period of three regularly scheduled working days, without using vacation or any other paid leave time.

Having considered the foregoing, the Commission hereby **APPROVES** the proposed terms of the settlement agreement.
