Dear Mr. Packer:

Pursuant to IC 4-22-2-28, the Indiana Economic Development Corporation ("IEDC") has reviewed the economic impact analysis for small business associated with rule changes proposed by the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") and contained in LSA Document 08-298. The proposed rule makes changes to Title 68 to change the definition of a "slot machine". The proposed rule changes the definition of "slot machine" from only referencing "electronic gaming device" to developing a separate set of criteria for what constitutes a "slot machine". This rule was necessitated by the creation of IC 4-35 and the legalization of slot facilities

The economic impact analysis for small businesses prepared by the Commission estimates that zero (0) small businesses will be impacted by this rule.

Since the proposed rule is not expected to affect any small businesses, it does not impose any direct cost or reporting costs on small businesses.
