EQUIPMENT REQUIRED FOR THE EVENT

- Proper fighting area
- Bell, whistle, stopwatch
- Set of scales
- Gloves to worn by professional unarmed combatants
- Cleaning solution of 10% bleach & 90% water
- System to dispose of blood borne pathogens
- Adequate supply of disposable hygienic gloves
- (2) Buckets
- (2) Sets of stairs for
- (1) Seat for an announcer
- (2) Stools for fighters
- (3) Seats in each corner for licensed seconds

EVENT NIGHT

- Weigh-ins is usually two hours before the fight. The Director of State Athletic Commission the must be contacted before scheduling weigh-ins and the Director of State Athletic Commission or his designee must be present at all weigh-ins.
- All contestants must be ready to enter the fighting area immediately upon the finish of the preceding match.

SEATING

- Seating in the area next to the ring apron on all four (4) sides of the ring is under the State Athletic Commission jurisdiction. The State Athletic Commission will provide a diagram or plan showing the seating arrangement prior to the contest or exhibition.

WITHIN (10) DAYS AFTER THE FIGHT

- Pay a 5% tax based on admission collected.
- Promoters shall pay the state a tax of \$ 1.00 each up to the limit of 5% complimentary tickets. After which the promoter will pay 5% of face value of ticket.
