Re: Request for Qualifications – Lead Community Action Program

IHCDA, in partnership with the Indiana Community Action Association (INCAA) is pleased to announce the release of Request for Qualifications: Lead Community Action Program.

Using Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Relief funding, the program aims to reduce exposure to lead-based paint hazards in pre-1978 owner occupied housing. Respondents will reduce exposure by:

- Performing lead inspections and risk assessments for approximately 144 owner-occupied units throughout the State of Indiana;
- Conducting lead hazard control (interim controls and/or abatement) activities in approximately 144 units statewide.

IHCDA and INCAA are seeking responses from Community Action Agencies and other nonprofit organizations to administer lead hazard control awards throughout 82 Counties in Indiana.

The program targets households that include children under the age of six or which have a frequently visiting child under the age of six, to limit their exposure to lead-based paint hazards which can be detrimental to their development.
