WHAT IS AN INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT ACCOUNT?

The Refugee Individual Development Account (IDA) Program helps newly resettled, low-income refugees learn how to manage their money and save toward a specific purpose:

AM I ELIGIBLE?

- ✓ Are you a recently resettled refugee (three years or less), asylee or a certified victim of human trafficking?
- ✓ Employed?
- ✓ Meet household requirements?
- ✓ Want to buy a home, start a business or further your education?

WHAT ARE THE INCOME REQUIREMENTS?

To qualify for Indiana's Refugee IDA Program, your household income cannot exceed the following limits:

HOUSEHOLD SIZE	HOUSEHOLD INCOME
1	\$ 21,660
2	\$ 29,140
3	\$ 36,620
4	\$ 44,100
5	\$ 51,580
6	\$ 59,060
7	\$ 66,540
8	\$ 74,020

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?
