Subject: State Propane Average Fuel Price

Program Guidance: WAP-2023-10

Background

Propane rates vary nearly daily by supplier, consumer, and region. Due to a preference among Weatherization staff, utilizing a state propane average fuel rate provided by the Energy Information Administration (EIA) is now permitted in place of supplier specific propane costs.

NEW GUIDANCE

Effective January 19th, 2023, IHCD will follow the following [link](#) to obtain EIA's state of Indiana annual propane average price. Subgrantees are advised to use **the following** annual average when it is cost advantageous to the specific cost of the propane purchase in energy modelling software. Subgrantees may utilize either supplier prices or annual propane average of \$2.583/ gallon (derived from the state averages between during the week ending on 10/03/2022 to 03/27/2023). This value will be updated as needed to reflect the market and at least annually.
