# Weatherization Auditor Training Classes

## Opening

The Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (IHCDA) is seeking individuals who are interested in serving as Weatherization Auditors for the State's Energy Conservation Program. Weatherization Auditors are responsible for home inspections, including attic and crawl space evaluations, diagnostic testing, energy audits, and composing work orders.

Ideal candidates possess strong math skills. Previous construction or HVAC experience preferred, but not required. Pre-test screenings will be held May 4-7, with background checks performed on selected candidates. Selected participants will be notified by May 14, with online training modules beginning May 18. Candidates who pass the pre-test screening will be invited to attend classroom training. These sessions will be held in the Northern (Elkhart), Central (Indianapolis), and Southern (Bedford) regions of the state June 8-11, followed by field training.

Please note that this training includes a three-week online course, with a minimum commitment of 10 hours per week, followed by a three-week onsite field training commitment including overnight stays.
