

New OJT Program Requirement for INDOT Prime Contractors

Beginning with the January 2019 enrollment process, INDOT will require all OJT program participants to submit an executed copy of their United States Department of Labor (USDOL) or Federal Highway (FHWA) approved OJT training program concurrent with their OJT partnership agreement. The submission of this document will assist INDOT by providing evidence that the trainee hours claimed are part of an approved program and decrease the potential for misrepresentation or fraud in the OJT program. Should your firm not have an approved training program in place, please contact David Gray with USDOL at gray.david@dol.gov or 317-226-7005 to determine if an approved training program is available for your line of work. USDOL will assist firms to enroll in an appropriate program and will supply proper documentation to verify enrollment. Should your firm be signatory to a union, please submit the entire executed union agreement for your firm.
