

Check Out Our New Website Design

As you may have noticed, the INDOT website has been redesigned. The design offers a different layout that should make navigating our site more convenient for users. Below are highlights:

- The most used pages have been brought to the home page. From here you can report concerns, access ongoing programs, get travel information, get updates on major projects, and many other topics.
- The INDOT Construction Map is located under the “Travel Information” tab. The map lists the road to be worked on, the start date of the project, and a site-specific map. The map allows you to access the projects and dollars spent in each county in the state. This will allow you to keep informed as to what projects are happening or are upcoming in your area.
- The left navigation drops down instead of popping out. The content in the left navigation is the same, but the new look will be more efficient and convenient. “Doing Business with INDOT” is still the tab, which will get you to both contracting and procurement opportunities.
- Access to the INDOT road weather sensors, which provide real-time road conditions for each weather sensor site.
- The new template is mobile friendly.
