Training & Recruiting Opportunities for CDL Drivers



Looking for CDL drivers? Vincennes University Logistics Training and Education Center (VU LTEC) in Plainfield welcomes the opportunity for companies to come to its facility and speak with CDL students who will be graduating from their six-week course about available career opportunities!

In 2017, the Indiana Department of Transportation awarded VU LTEC an On-the-Job Training/Supportive Services grant through the Federal Highway Administration, aimed at providing CDL Class A training to women, minorities and economically disadvantaged individuals. The purpose of this grant is to increase the number of individuals who receive training and ultimately obtain their CDL license, to enter jobs within the transportation/heavy highway industry.

VU LTEC begins a new CDL training class the first Monday of every month. The training program lasts six weeks, focusing heavily on hands-on driving application. During the course of the six-week program, VU LTEC invites employers that are seeking CDL drivers to come in and speak with students about available CDL employment opportunities. These sessions can be scheduled as needed or during each six-week class. Session times are available Mondays through Fridays from 8 to 8:30 a.m. or from 11:30 a.m. to noon.
