Daytime I-65 and nighttime I-80/94 restrictions continue

Work progressing on Major Moves Interchange Modification project

LAKE COUNTY, Ind. – The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) announces daytime restrictions on I-65 and nighttime restrictions on I-80/94 are scheduled to continue through the week as weather allows. This work is part of the Major Moves New Construction Interchange Modification project at I-65 and I-80/94 (the Frank Borman Expressway).

During the day, the right lanes of north and southbound I-65 between the ramp to westbound I-80/94 and the ramp to eastbound I-80/94 will periodically be restricted for preliminary bridge work.

During the night, various lanes of I-80/94 between Martin Luther King Drive and Central Avenue will be restricted while demolition of the Colorado Street bridge over I-80/94 continues. Also, between midnight and 5 a.m. there will be 20-minute closures of the entire roadway for bridge beam removal or equipment relocation.

INDOT reminds drivers to use caution and keep in mind worker safety when traveling through a construction zone. The work schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather.

Gov. Mitch Daniels' Major Moves transportation plan fully funds a decade of critical highway projects in Indiana. When Major Moves is complete in 2015, more than 200 new construction and 200 major highway preservation projects will have been built. This innovative plan will bring jobs to the Hoosier State and leave a legacy for Indiana to be a global leader in distribution and logistics.
