



4.0 MONITORING AND REPORTING

INDOT will monitor and report the project's activities associated with the commitments and mitigation measures discussed in the Section 106 MOA, the Conceptual Wetland Mitigation Plan and any other more detailed mitigation and monitoring plans developed for the project, the FEIS, and this ROD, to ensure that they are carried out. To ensure compliance with all appropriate federal and state regulations, all necessary permits will be applied for and obtained prior to construction, and the terms and conditions of these permits will be adhered to during the construction and maintenance of this facility.

The following Federal permits relating to terrestrial and aquatic resources relative to waters of the US will be required for any build alternative, including the Selected Alternative.

United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE)	Section 404 Permit for the Discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States (e.g. streams and wetlands)

The following permits from the State of Indiana relating to terrestrial and aquatic resources will be required for any build alternative, including the Selected Alternative.

Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM)	Section 401 Water Quality Certification IDEM Isolated Wetlands Regulatory Program
Indiana Department of Natural Resources (IDNR)	Permit Construction in a Floodway

The following agencies regulate a "permit by rule." Though no actual permit is issued, proper correspondence and the incorporation of specific measures in design and construction are required prior to commencing construction activities.
