Jay Wasson was appointed Deputy Commissioner of Engineering and Asset Management in 2012. He provides management oversight for a large portion of INDOT's technical staff, including nine major departments: Asset Management & Planning, Bridges, Environmental Services, Highway Design, Multi-modal, Pavement, Real Estate, Research & Development and Traffic Engineering. Wasson also provides additional support services to foster department-wide innovation and ensure that departments effectively deliver their programs at the lowest possible cost to tax payers.

An 18-year INDOT employee, Jay previously served as Director of Research & Development from 2010 to 2012. He also worked in the field of Intelligent Transportation Systems from 1998 to 2010 and served as Director for the Traffic Management Centers Division that included management of the Hoosier Helper freeway service patrol. Jay began his INDOT career in 1993 as a cooperative education student worker in the Greenfield District.

Jay holds a Bachelor of Science degree in civil engineering and a Master of Science degree in civil engineering, both from Purdue University. Jay is also a registered engineer in Indiana. He has served various leadership roles within the Institute of Transportation Engineers (ITE) including the Indiana Section President in 2007. Jay has co-authored numerous peer reviewed technical papers for professional journals and has been an invited speaker to technical conferences both domestic and abroad.
