Troy Woodruff was appointed Chief of Staff in May 2012, leading the agency's Operations, Communications, Public Information, Local Public Agency/Metropolitan Planning Organizations and Grants Administration, Multi Modal, Innovation and Enhancement, Contracts and Legislative Affairs divisions.

Troy previously served as INDOT Deputy Commissioner of Operations, where he was responsible for all construction, maintenance and traffic operations statewide, including 3,200 employees and a \$290 million annual operating budget. From 2009 to 2010, he led field operations for one of INDOT's six regional districts covering 16 counties in southwest Indiana as the Vincennes District Deputy Commissioner.

Prior to joining INDOT, Troy held consecutive regional director positions with the Indiana Department of Environmental Management and Anthem Insurance. He has represented southwest Indiana as a member of the Indiana House of Representatives and as a field representative for former Congressman John Hostettler.

Troy is a graduate of Indiana State University and holds a Bachelor of Science degree in communications.
