### **I-469 Concrete Restoration Scheduled to Begin Monday, April 27**

*Work will restrict I-469 to one lane in each direction between Feighner Road bridge and Winchester Road bridge*

**FORT WAYNE** – The Indiana Department of Transportation announces that Interstate 469 in Allen County is scheduled for a concrete restoration project, from .54 miles to 8.82 miles east of I-69, beginning Monday, April 27, weather permitting.

During construction, I-469 will be restricted to one lane in each direction for up to four miles, but all exit ramps will remain open. The restriction will continue through late summer when motorists may see sections of concrete curing throughout the project.

INDOT reminds drivers to use caution and consider worker safety when driving through an active construction zone. The speed limit through the construction zone will be reduced to 60 mph, and lowered to 50 mph when crews are present. Motorists should be on the lookout for flashing speed limit signs throughout the work zone.

The project was awarded to Harper Company Contractors for \$1.4 million.

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
