I-469 Traffic Shift Scheduled for Wednesday, May 20

Westbound I-469 traffic will shift to eastbound lanes and westbound Winchester Road exits will close

ALLEN COUNTY – The Indiana Department of Transportation announces that westbound traffic on I-469, between S.R. 1/mile marker 6 and Marion Center Road/mile marker 13, will be shifted to the eastbound lanes on Wednesday, May 20. The westbound Winchester Road exit ramps will be closed at that time.

Motorists traveling west on I-469 will use the crossovers constructed in the medians, while westbound lanes are replaced.

The reduced speed limit of 55 mph will be enforced. INDOT reminds drivers to use caution and consider worker safety when driving through an active work zone.

The two-construction season project will also include bridge deck rehabilitation on bridges over Snyder Ditch, the St. Mary's River and U.S. 27, as well as the total pavement replacement of the eastbound segment in 2016. The project was awarded to Primco for \$24 million.

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
