



Explicit Runway Crossing Procedure Change

- **Beginning June 30, 2010**, controllers will be required to issue explicit instructions to cross or hold short of each runway that intersects a taxi route.
- "Taxi to" will no longer be used when issuing taxi instructions to an assigned take-off runway.
- Instructions to cross a runway normally will be issued one at a time. An aircraft or vehicle must have crossed the previous runway before another runway crossing is issued. Exceptions may apply for closely spaced runways.
- This applies to any runway including inactive or closed runways.
- Changes will also be made to the AIM and AIP to reflect the new procedures.
- Never cross a hold line without *explicit* ATC instructions. If in doubt ASK!
- <u>Reminder</u>: You may not enter a runway unless you have been: instructed to cross or taxi onto that specific runway; cleared to take off from that runway; or instructed to position and hold on that specific runway.
