We have reviewed the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) amendment requests you submitted via correspondence dated June 17, 2015 and June 23, 2015. These requests add projects pursuant to changes made to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Madison County Council of Governments (MCCOG) and the Delaware-Muncie Metropolitan Plan Commission (DMMPC).

The amended TIPs have been endorsed by the appropriate Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs). The projects listed in the attached STIP amendment table (Attachment 1) are eligible for FTA funding.

We have determined that the amendments to the TIP and STIP are financially constrained and consistent with the relevant MPO and statewide transportation plans. The projects were developed in accordance with the requirements of 23 CFR 450, and are exempt from the air quality conformity determination process. The project additions are approved for the FY2014-2017 STIP.

Please find attached a Metropolitan Planning Organization TIP amendment which must be approved and included into the FY 2014 State Transportation Improvement Program. We will reflect by reference the 2014 – 2017 federal aid projects covered by this approval in our 2014 - 2017 STIP. The amendment is for the Delaware-Muncie Metropolitan Plan Commission (Muncie MPO). The resolution number for the Muncie MPO amendment is 14-24.

We have determined that the proposed amendments are: 1) consistent with the transportation plan; 2) the TIP remains fiscally constrained in that federal funding resources are sufficient to support the new or modified projects and 3) conform to state and national air quality standards as required by the Federal Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990.

RESOLUTION 14-24

- WHEREAS, the Delaware-Muncie Metropolitan Plan Commission (DMMPC) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), as designated by the Governor of the State of Indiana, for the Muncie Urbanized Area; and
- WHEREAS, the Administrative Committee is the policy committee of the Metropolitan Planning Organization involved in the transportation planning process for the Muncie Urbanized Area; and
- WHEREAS, the FY 2014-2017 DMTIP is in agreement with the 2013-2040 Delaware Muncie Transportation Plan, which conforms with the Indiana State Implementation Plan (SIP); and
- WHEREAS, the FY 2014-17 DMTIP needed to be changed to add a transit sidewalk FTA project using STP Urban funds flexed to FTA funding; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed DMTIP amendment to add an FTA transit sidewalk project was reviewed and approved by the Technical Advisory Committee at its monthly meeting on November 13, 2014; and
- WHEREAS, the same proposed amendment was reviewed and approved by the Administrative Committee at its monthly meeting on November 19, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Administrative Committee of the DMMPC as follows:

Section 1. That the Fiscal Year 2014-2017 Delaware Muncie Transportation Improvement Program is amended to add a Muncie Indiana Transit System (MITS) sidewalk project to enhance access to transit routes in Muncie using \$350,000 of STP Urban funds flexed to FTA funds in FY 2015 for preliminary engineering (PE) costing \$27,500 (\$22,000 federal/\$5,500 local) and construction (CN) costing \$410,000 (\$328,000 federal/\$82,000 local). $Des^{\pm} 140/815$
