Please find attached a Metropolitan Planning Organization TIP amendment which must be approved and included into the FY 2012 State Transportation Improvement Program. We will reflect by reference the 2012 – 2015 federal aid projects covered by this approval in our 2012 - 2015 STIP. ADOPTION RESOLUTION FY 2012-08

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2012-2015 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM TO ADD TWO NEW PROJECTS FOR BLOOMINGTON TRANSIT AND THE STATE OF INDIANA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION as presented to the Policy Committee of the Bloomington/Monroe County Metropolitan Planning Organization on February 8, 2013.

WHEREAS, the Bloomington/Monroe County Metropolitan Planning Organization (BMCMPPO) is the organization designated by the Governor of Indiana as the Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible for carrying out, with the State of Indiana, the provisions of 23 U.S.C. 134, and capable of meeting the requirements thereof for the Bloomington, Indiana urbanized area; and

WHEREAS, the BMCMPPO must develop and maintain a Transportation Improvement Program to illustrate how federal funds will be expended on transportation projects within the metropolitan planning area; and


WHEREAS, Bloomington Transit has identified the need to add a project to the Bloomington/Monroe County Metropolitan Planning Organization Fiscal Year 2012-2015 Transportation Improvement Program.

 - Added DES # 1382016, Bloomington Transit Downtown Transfer Facility Furnishings
- (2) This resolution shall be forwarded to all relevant public officials and government agencies, and shall be available for public inspection during regular business hours at the City of Bloomington Planning Department, located in the Showers Center City Hall at 401 North Morton Street, Bloomington, Indiana.
