General Comments on I69 impact for survey:

Hoosier Hills Food Bank, 2333 W Industrial Park Drive

Our organization is located on Industrial Park Drive, with access from SR 37 at Vernal Pike. The only other access to Industrial Park Drive is Vernal Pike west to Curry Pike.

Daily, we send out up to 5 vehicles (box trucks and vans) to collect food from local grocery stores, restaurants and businesses in Bloomington as well as from stores and food sources in Spencer, Bedford, and Paoli. We will soon be expanding regular retail pick ups to Mitchell, Shoals, Loogootee, West Baden and French Lick.

Daily, several dozen agencies, many from Bloomington but also from Spencer, Nashville, Bedford, Mitchell, Paoli, French Lick and Loogootee come to the food bank to collect food for their food pantries and soup kitchens. We distribute over 3.2 million pounds of food annually to over 90 agencies.

Several times each week, we receive deliveries of food from various vendors and sources, including semi-trailer loads of food. Several times each week we send our delivery vehicles out to Spencer, Nashville, Paoli, French Lick, Orleans, Bedford, and Mitchell.

In addition to our staff, dozens of volunteers each week come to our facility to assist in our operations. Most come from the campus/downtown Bloomington area.

An underpass at Vernal Pike must be high enough to accommodate all of our trucks and the semi trailers that come to deliver to us. Bike lanes would be beneficial as some of our staff and volunteers use bicycles to get to us from town. It is critical that an alternative access to 37 and east into Bloomington be maintained during any construction at the Vernal Pike intersection – failure to do so and to require a detour that involves only having access from the west side of Vernal Pike (meaning all the way down to Curry Pike) would be expensive and extremely disruptive for us and all the other businesses on Industrial Park Drive.

Punching Industrial Park Drive through to the Kohl's/Gates Drive shopping complex area would be highly desirable. And it would be extremely desirable to complete this prior to commencing work on the Vernal Pike intersection at 37.

Access to SR 37 is important. When we lose access to 37 at Vernal Pike, it is important that we minimize the route on local access roads to get to it. Significantly increased travel time will increase our fuel bill and required staff time. As a non-profit food bank, increased costs of this type may hamper our ability to fulfill our mission. This situation is equally critical for our customers, who are also non-profit agencies with limited budgets and who often use volunteers. If access to the food bank is impeded, they will reduce their visits and will not be able to access as much food for their programs. They also have time and fuel cost considerations.





For Project Consideration,

As the planning moves forward for Section 5 of the I-69 project we would like to draw particular attention to the portion of highway located between Sample Rd and Chambers Pike. Both alternatives currently being discussed locate an interchange at Sample Rd and a grade separation (overpass) located at Chambers Pike. The businesses represented by Parker Pools, Poynter Sheet Metal, Oliver Winery and Worm's Way require a considerable amount of truck and customer traffic. We are concerned that funneling all the combined traffic through one interchange could tax the design and create potential hazards. The addition of an interchange at Chambers Pike could elevate any potential problems by separating the traffic flow between two interchanges and still meet the highway interchange separation requirements.

The current truck and customer traffic at Oliver Winery consists of the follow:

- Oliver Winery sees an average of **25** tractor-trailer trucks **each week** throughout the year. With a slightly heavier volume in the fall (Sept. – Oct.)
- This number is expected to grow considerably over the next few years, approaching 50 trucks a week by 2014 -2016
- Weekend customer traffic (Friday, Saturday, Sunday) for an entire year averages **989 vehicles** each three day weekend period.
- During seasonal peak periods of the year May through November this average jumps to **1200 vehicles**, with a high of **1,524** for one weekend in September.

I do not believe there is just compensation for the blood, sweat and tears that I have invested in my home and grounds. Our business is located in our home and shop and is our lifeline. Without which our business would most likely go under. The office is located within the home where calls are answered, appointments are scheduled and all paperwork is completed. The shop is where appliances are repaired, stored and sold. Our repair center and sales area is 1800 sq feet, the home is 2640 sq feet making a total of 4400 sq feet. It would be impossible to invest in 4400sq feet of home and work space for your "fair market value". Robinson Appliance Service has been advertising this location and phone number in the yellow pages, internet, newspaper and magnets for 39 years. This investment has cost the business approximately \$250,000 since we began the company. We are a wholesale bakery production facility which sells and provides fresh baked goods to a variety of commercial accounts throughout the state of Indiana. 
