

### Stakeholder Working Group

A Stakeholder Working Group (SWG) is comprised of technical individuals who represent local government agencies within the Section 6 Study Area. These individuals have technical expertise in planning, engineering and public works departments. They provide input related to engineering, access, environmental constraints and public outreach. They also disseminate project information to others within their organization.

### Community Advisory Committee

A Community Advisory Committee (CAC) has two primary functions: 1) provide feedback regarding the project and 2) disseminate project information to the organizations they represent. CAC members represent larger local organizations within a community. Examples include neighborhood associations, Emergency Responders, school corporations, economic development organizations, parks departments and logistics companies. They are expected to update their membership about the project. CAC members also provide valuable input into the transportation planning process. They have vast local knowledge about their community that is valuable to the project team.
