

Gender Communications:

Every conversation has a purpose.

Use literal language. No hidden meanings. Fewer words.

Ask the right questions.

Fact-based

Men don't give “listening” body cues.

Timing

Women are like spaghetti: thinking and communicating about several things at once. They respond to caring.

Use words like, “I feel” “I care”

Conversations build consensus, go through the process.

Look for hidden, subtle meanings

When a question is not a question.

“Do you want me to just listen, or would you like me to offer advice?”
