PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS,** the incidents of crime, alcohol and drug abuse, suicides, domestic situations and broken homes occur daily in our society; and
- WHEREAS,** the professional public safety dispatcher is the pivotal link between citizens and those who provide services when accidents or emergencies occur and require the assistance of firemen, policemen or EMS services; and
- WHEREAS,** professional public safety dispatchers perform their daily tasks in a dedicated, diligent and loyal manner while enduring the occupational stresses of shift work, confinement, periods of heavy volumes of radio traffic, and crisis situations requiring responsible and decisive actions; and
- WHEREAS,** the State of Indiana is fortunate to be blessed with dedicated and well-trained professional public safety dispatchers; and
- WHEREAS,** these professionals need and deserve informed citizen support and recognition for their commitment and devotion to quality public safety dispatching services;
