TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:



- WHEREAS,** the professional public safety dispatcher is the pivotal link between citizens and those who provide services when accidents or emergency circumstances occur which require the assistance of firemen, policemen and EMS services; and
- WHEREAS,** professional public safety dispatchers perform their daily tasks in a dedicated, diligent and loyal manner while enduring the occupational stresses of shift work, confinement, periods of heavy volumes of radio traffic, and crisis situations requiring responsible and decisive actions; and
