Year 2009 Activity Report

Community Programs

- 196 **Comprehensive Health Screenings** that included screening for heart disease, diabetes and cancer were given at two community sites. A quarterly health screening was also provided at the local uninsured health clinic.
- **Mammogram Promotion** includes Breast Cancer awareness month using flyers, brochures and newspaper articles, participating in Tell-A-Friend by helping with the county wide kick off in October and at our health screening all year long as part of the cancer risk factor screening process. We collected Yoplait Yogurt lids for the "Save Lids, Save Lives" program.
- **Pamphlets and flyers** on all types of early detection measures were distributed by the Community Outreach Department.
- **Bloomingtonhospital.org website** provided information related to tests and check ups for early detection of many diseases.
- **Diabetic Support Group** meetings provided a monthly educational opportunity to an average of 8 to 15 diabetics and their friends and family. These meetings included a speaker or activity and take home materials. Staff members are available to answer questions and give guidance.
- Assistance was provided to **Community Support Groups**, such as Prevent Child Abuse Orange County, MS Support Group and the Breastfeeding Support Group.
- The Hospital participated in **Relay for Life** by coordinating the First Aid Station. Health education and safety information was provided to the team members to prevent injuries.
- BHOC **Adult CPR** training was given to 71 Community members. BHOC **Infant/Child CPR** training was given to 39 community members. BHOC **First Aid** training was given to 50 Community members. **AED** training was given to 1 Community member. Preventing Disease Transmission was also given to 14 community members.
- 429 flu shots were provided to the Community.
- Monthly **Tobacco Cessation Classes** were held with nicotine patches available. The hospital participated in the Kick Butt's Day event.
- **Senior Health Insurance Information** counseling was provided to 77 individuals.
- **A Senior Fair** provided thirty four educational booths with over 100 seniors in attendance.
- **Car Seat Education** information was distributed at the hospital and two local events. A car seat injury prevention presentation was provided to a local employer. Car seat inspections were provided during the year with four car seats being distributed.

School Programs

- **Hospital tours** were provided to 111 students from preschool to 10th grade. They received take home packets of information related to their health care interests.
- **BHOC Adult CPR** was provided for 575 students and First Aid was provided to 121 students.
- **Health Careers Presentation** was provided to 51 students.
- **Tobacco Education Program** was presented to 385 students from Springs Valley, Paoli & Orleans Community Schools.
- The **Poison Prevention Program** was offered to 1,098 students. Our staff visited 8 area schools and 3 preschool/daycare centers. The information was also presented to a local employer.
- The **Handwashing Program** was presented to 531 students at 3 public schools, 1 preschool, and 1 after school program. A video and glow germ light is used to demonstrate how easily germs are spread, how to properly wash your hands and is available for all ages.
- Coordinated the Safe Kids Orange County activities which included:
 - Walk to School Pedestrian Safety Program – 290 children
 - Trunk or Treat – in excess of 250 kids and parents
 - Breakfast with Santa – 170 kids & 110 parents
