RE: Final Adoption of Commercial Onsite Sewage Systems, 410 IAC 6-10.1-94 (LSA Doc. #12-616)

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH), Environmental Public Health Division, requests the Executive Board, at the Board's July 10, 2013, meeting, finally adopt the administrative rule governing Commercial Onsite Sewage Systems, 410 IAC 6-10.1-94.

The proposed rule amends 410 IAC 6-10.1-94 to add that the department may approve a method to break up compaction if compacted soil material is identified in the soil at a depth greater than twelve (12) inches.

The Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule was published in the Indiana Register on November 28, 2012, starting the one year period to adopt this rule. The proposed rule was preliminarily adopted by the Executive Board at the January 9, 2013, meeting. No changes have been made to the rule.
