RE: Preliminary Adoption of Residential On-Site Sewage Systems, 410 IAC 6-8.3 (LSA Doc. #13-350)

The Indiana State Department of Health requests that the Executive Board, at the Board's September 11, 2013, meeting, adopt the proposed amendments to the Residential On-Site Sewage Systems, 410 IAC 6-8.3. The proposed rule would amend 410 IAC 6-8.3 concerning the definition of residential sewer, amend the requirement for ownership of a temporary sewage holding tank, amend the separation distance between an on-site sewage system and a lake or reservoir used as a public water supply, amend the requirement for the construction of septic tank baffles, clarify the daily flow rating for septic tank outlet filters, amend the discharge rate for flood dosed systems, correct the volume of a dosing tank under certain conditions, and amend the requirement for removal of abandoned buried electric lines.

A Notice of Intent was published on the Indiana Register Website on July 31, 2013, starting the one year period to adopt this rule amendment.
