RE: Preliminary Adoption of 410 IAC 6-10.1-94 (LSA Doc. #12-616)

The Indiana State Department of Health requests that the Executive Board, at the Board's January 9, 2013, meeting, preliminarily adopt 410 IAC 6-10.1-94, Commercial On-Site Sewage Systems. The proposed rule amends 410 IAC 6-10.1-94 to add that the department may approve a method to break up compaction if compacted soil material is identified in the soil at a depth greater than twelve (12) inches.

A Notice of Intent was published on the Indiana Register Website on November 28, 2012, starting the one-year period to adopt this rule amendment.
