RE: Readoption of Public Health Surveillance & Preparedness Rules

As part of the larger readoption of rules for the Indiana State Department of Health, the Public Health Surveillance & Preparedness Commission requests the Executive Board to readopt various rules in Title 410 of the Indiana Administrative Code that pertain to the programs making up the Public Health Surveillance & Preparedness Commission. A review of each rule to be readopted is attached. Those rules to be readopted are as follows:

410 IAC 1-2.4	Electronic Reporting of Emergency Department Visit Abstract Data by Hospitals
410 IAC 1-6	Offering of Human Immunodeficiency Virus Information and Counseling and Human Immunodeficiency Virus Testing
410 IAC 32	LEAD-BASED PAINT PROGRAM

Following readoption by the Executive Board, a notice of readoption will be filed with the Indiana Register and the rules will not expire on January 1, 2012. The rules will continue in effect for another 7 years or until amended.
