School Indoor Air Quality Coordinators!

According to 410 IAC 33 all schools, both public and private, are required to have an individual designated as their Indoor Air Coordinator.

The Indiana State Department of Health is offering this one day training for all Indoor Air Quality Coordinators! Maintenance staff and Administrators are encouraged to attend. This is an introduction level training open to everyone but is tailored for School Indoor Air Coordinators with little background in IAQ, and schools still developing the required IAQ policies and procedures.

Training will cover:

- How the school IAQ rule affects your school
- Selecting Green chemicals
- Filter selection
- Asthma
- Indoor Air Quality instrumentation
- Open discussion time to cover your school's issues
