The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH), Environmental Public Health Division, requests the Executive Board, at the Board's September 12, 2012, meeting, finally adopt the administrative rule governing Commercial Onsite Sewage Systems, 410 IAC 6-10.1.

The proposed rule updates and clarifies agency requirements pertaining to the design, construction, installation, maintenance, and operation of commercial onsite sewage systems. The proposed rule also repeals 410 IAC 6-10.

The Notice of Intent to Adopt a Rule was published in the Indiana Register on April 4, 2012, starting the one year period to adopt this rule. The proposed rule was preliminarily adopted by the Executive Board at the May 9, 2012, meeting. Although minor changes have been made based on public comment, the rule has not substantively changed.
