Overview

The Indiana Spinal Cord and Brain Injury Fund (ISCBIRF) is a state-supported program that funds research for the treatment and cure of spinal cord and traumatic brain injuries (TBI).

The main objectives of the conference are to acquaint interested parties, clinicians and scientists as well as consumers, with the research supported by the ISCBIRF and to provide a forum for researchers funded by the ISCBIRF to learn about each other's work and facilitate collaborations.

The poster presentation is in pursuit of these two objectives and is a primary time when ISCBIRF researchers can learn of each other's work, interact and network.

We invite individuals who currently receive or have received ISCBIRF funding and strongly encourage current grantees to present a poster.

Submission

Poster abstracts should not exceed 250 words and follow a standard format to include: Objective(s), Method, Results, and Conclusions.

GUIDELINES for APPROVED POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Display Poster Size	<p>The poster board is 8 feet wide by 4 feet high (2.44 x 1.22 meters) (Landscape Orientation).</p> <p>The mounting surface (usable space) is 7 feet 6 inches wide by 3 feet 6 inches high (1.06 x 2.28 meters) Landscape Orientation. It is recommended that your poster presentation, whether professionally produced or not, fill the “usable space” of the board as much as possible.</p>
Attendance	<p>Please arrive at the IU Health Neuroscience Center between 8:00 a.m.-8:30 a.m. to mount your poster. Post materials on the board and leave them for the full session. At least one of the poster authors is required to REGISTER at the conference to give a brief presentation of the poster during the interactive breaks and lunch, as well as staying with the poster to discuss the work with conference attendees.</p> <p>Posters must be dismounted at the conclusion of the conference.</p>
Poster Layout	<p>Bring only items that can be mounted on the poster board. Handout materials may be included in an envelope attached to the display board. Electrical outlets will not be available. You may display items on your poster board that relate to your abstract/poster presentation only. No soliciting is allowed; therefore any non-presentation related items will be removed from your board.</p> <p>All items for posting must be prepared in advance. Graphic supplies or services will not be available.</p>
Provided by ISDH	<p>ISDH provides the bulletin board and push pins.</p>
