RE: Readoption Public Health Preparedness and Laboratory Services Commission Rules

As part of the larger readoption of rules for the Indiana State Department of Health, the Public Health Preparedness and Laboratory Services Commission requests the Executive Board to readopt various rules in Title 410 of the Indiana Administrative Code that pertain to the programs making up the Public Health Preparedness and Laboratory Services Commission. A review of the rule to be readopted is attached. The rule to be readopted is as follows:

410 IAC 6-7.1	Campgrounds
410 IAC 6-7.2	Youth Camps
410 IAC 6-14	Railroad Mobile Camps
410 IAC 7-21	Wholesale Food Establishment Sanitation Requirements

Following readoption by the Executive Board, a notice of readoption will be filed with the Indiana Register and the rules will not expire on January 1, 2015. The rule will continue in effect for another 7 years or until amended.
