410 IAC 1-2.3                      DISEASE REPORTING AND CONTROL

Following readoption by the Executive Board, a notice of readoption will be filed with the Indiana Register and the rule will not expire on January 1, 2013. The rule will continue in effect for another 7 years or until amended.
