Pursuant to IC 4-22-2-28, the Indiana Office of Small Business and Entrepreneurship ("OSBE") has reviewed the economic impact analysis for small business associated with rule changes contained in LSA Document 13-483 proposed by the Indiana State Department of Health ("ISDH"). The proposed rule would amend 410 IAC 12.1 to update the rule to include the latest versions of the ASTM International (ASTM) standards that apply to motor fuel, octane and ethanol fuel blends and to update references to sections of the Indiana Code that were repealed.
