EMERGENCY STOP-SALE ORDER

You are **NOTIFIED** that the Division of Weights and Measures, Indiana State Department of Health, pursuant to Indiana Code 16-44-3-7 (2) and Indiana code 4-21.5-4 et seq. hereby **ORDERS YOU TO IMMEDIATELY STOP THE SALE** of motor fuel from the fuel pumps dispensing grades (87) & (89) octane motor fuel, at the facility known as **BP-Peru Stop & Go**, located at **452 W. Main Street, Peru , Indiana 46970**.

This order is based upon the following: **BP- Peru Stop & Go** is a motor fuel outlet facility engaged in the sale of retail motor fuel to the public.

On May 14, 2013 a Representative of the Division of Weights and Measures, Indiana State Department of Health, conducted an inspection of **BP- Peru Stop & Go** facilities of the unleaded (87) & 89 octane grades of gasoline. The results of Gasoila paste test conducted on said motor fuel storage tanks reveals 13 inches of water/ phase separation in the (87) & (89) unleaded storage tank which are blender pumps at this location.

ASTM Standard for unleaded fuels is no more than ¼ of inch of water in storage tank.

This is a violation of the Indiana Code 16-44-3-1 et seq., and 410 IAC 12.1-2-2(a), “Standard Specification for Automotive Spark-Ignition Engine Fuel”.

YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED TO IMMEDIATELY STOP THE SALE of (87) & (89) octane unleaded fuels from the fuel pumps dispensing at the facility known as: **BP – Peru Stop & Go 452 W. Main Street, Peru, Indiana 46970**.



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This **ORDER** shall remain in effect until such time as the fuel has been corrected in accordance with 410 IAC 12.1-2-3 (e) or has been disposed of in accordance with 410 IAC 12.1-2-3 (d).

This **ORDER** is effective upon issuance.

If you wish to request a hearing on this **ORDER**, pursuant to IC 4-21-.5-4, you are required to forward a written request to the Indiana State Department of Health, at the office of Secretary, 2 North Meridian Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204 on or before **June 14, 2013.**
