## Infection Prevention Course for Long Term Care Professionals

The University of Indianapolis Center for Aging & Community is offering educational opportunities in Infection Prevention as part of the Indiana State Department of Health's (ISDH) Advanced Education project. The education provided in this training will prepare participants to pursue certification in these disciplines, if they so choose.

The Advanced Education in Infection Prevention courses will be taught by an Association for Professionals in Infection Control and Epidemiology (APIC) instructor with credentials from the Certification Board of Infection Control and Epidemiology, Inc. This course requires the following:

1. A two-day face-to-face session -- April 13 & 14, 2015
2. Online module work from April to August 2015
3. A two-day face-to-face session -- August 3 & 4, 2015

Participants completing the course with a passing grade will receive a Certificate of Training: Infection Prevention in the Long-Term Care Setting from APIC. To register, click below:
