



Population by age group






### Percent of adults who smoke




### Lung cancer deaths per 100,000 residents

**Births affected by smoking** **93**  
*low birth weight, SIDS, reduced lung function*

**Cost of smoking related births** **\$160,663**

## TOBACCO CONTROL FUNDING

The CDC recommends the Indiana government spend **\$78 million** each year on tobacco prevention and control programs.  
 Actual spending in Indiana: **\$10 million**

**\$4.8 billion**  
 Economic cost in Indiana due to smoking, according to the Centers for Disease Control.  
 Cost per Indiana citizen: **\$740**
