

Population by race






TOBACCO AND HEALTH IN PULASKI COUNTY


Percent of adults who smoke




Lung cancer deaths per 100,000 residents

TOBACCO CONTROL FUNDING

The CDC recommends the Indiana government spend **\$78 million** each year on tobacco prevention and control programs.

Actual spending in Indiana: **\$10 million**

\$4.8 billion
