




Population by race



Percent of adults who smoke




Smoking and pregnancy

Cost of smoking related births **\$576,077**


Lung cancer deaths per 100,000 residents

Cardiovascular disease deaths per 100,000 residents





TOBACCO CONTROL FUNDING

\$134,820

Funding in Vigo County for July 2011- June 2013.

The CDC recommends the Indiana government spend **\$78 million** each year on tobacco prevention and control programs.

Actual spending in Indiana: **\$10 million**

COMMUNITY INDICATORS

Protect and maintain local tobacco control coalition infrastructure needed to combat tobacco use, as well as working with community organizations to reduce tobacco use among those groups most impacted by tobacco

Protect Hoosiers from exposures to secondhand smoke by:

- Supporting local or statewide smoke-free air ordinances for worksites, including restaurants, bars and gaming facilities

- Implementing tobacco-free campus policies for hospitals, health care centers, mental health centers and clinics, and addiction treatment centers
- Working toward smoke-free policies in public housing
- Assisting college and university campuses to implement comprehensive tobacco-free policies

Decrease adult smoking rates by:

- Promoting the Indiana Tobacco Quitline (1-800-QUIT NOW) throughout the community
