SUPERLOAD MOTOR CARRIER ESCORT AGREEMENT

REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS:

1. A copy of the issued permit
2. A listing of the designated slowdowns
3. Exact location where the Superload will begin and exact location where it will end

Escorts cannot be set up until the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division has received all of the required attachments.

The Indiana State Police Department will provide police escorts, as required by the Indiana Department of Transportation or the Indiana Department of Revenue permit division, for Superload movements through Indiana under the following conditions:

1. Request for escorts shall be submitted at least three (3) working days, prior to the date for which the proposed escort is projected to take place. The three (3) working day period will begin once all of the required documents are received by Indiana State Police Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division.
2. The Company agrees to reimburse the Indiana State Police for the wages of each officer assigned to the detail at the rate of \$ 34.00 per hour and \$0.44 per mile for the use of each assigned officer's commission (mileage and Hours are computed round trip from the officer's home).
3. The company will hold the Indiana State Police , its employee(s) and the State of Indiana, harmless from any and all claims, demands, suits, liabilities and causes of action, of whatever kind and

designation, and wherever located in the State Of Indiana, resulting from gross negligence or omissions by your company and/or employee(s).

4. The driver shall have a copy of the current annual inspection for all vehicles, a valid CDL and a valid medical card.
5. The person responsible for steering the superload from the rear (if applicable) shall have a valid Class A CDL and medical card.
6. Upon entering the State Of Indiana, all Superload vehicles shall be inspected for compliance with all INDOT permits and ISP requirements and will be completed outside of the permitted travel time outlined in the INDOT Special Provisions for Superloads. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in the delay of the load being transported until compliance is achieved.
7. The company shall acknowledge and confirm that all relevant local governments, railroad and utility companies, have been contacted regarding this movement. A listing of such local governments, railroad and utility companies, points of contact, and telephone numbers shall be provided to the Indiana State Police upon request.
8. The company shall have shutdown locations pre-arranged with permission from the specific property owners e.g.: truck stops etc; and provide a copy of this information to the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division.
9. The company will abide by all Special Provisions for Superloads provided by Indiana Department of Transportation or Indiana Department of Revenue permits.
10. The total number of Indiana State Police escorts required for the move will be determined by the Indiana State Police Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Division based on the size and weight of the load as well as the route of travel to ensure safe movement of the load.
11. Private escorts, hired by the company, will be under the direction of the Indiana State Police Officer in Charge during all Indiana State Police escorted movements.
12. In case of inclement weather, it will be the discretion of the Indiana State Police OIC whether the movement will continue or be parked.
13. The Indiana State Police will not routinely provide transportation for the driver during the course of the movement.
14. Hours of movement are from 8:30a.m. to 3:30p.m. (Local time) unless prior authorization is given from the Superload administrator at the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement division Office.
