Dear Communications Service Provider:

The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) periodically gathers data to provide the Indiana General Assembly with timely information on communications issues. The IURC has a statutory mandate to report on the effects of competition and technological change on universal service and on pricing of telecommunications services. The statute also requires reporting on the status of competition and technological change in the provision of video services in Indiana.

In order for us to fulfill this objective and complete our report in a timely manner, we request that you complete the IURC Communications Survey and return it to the IURC Communications Division no later than April 1, 2011. The survey does change from year to year, so please check the date on the front page of the survey to ensure that you are completing the 2011 survey. Completed surveys may be submitted in three different ways: email attachment, mailed paper copy, or as a "general submission" using the IURC's Electronic Filing System (EFS).
