To: All Communications Service Providers

The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (IURC) periodically gathers data to provide the Indiana General Assembly with timely information on communications issues. The IURC has a statutory mandate to report on the effects of competition and technological change on universal service and on pricing of telecommunications services. Furthermore, we are tasked with reporting on the status of competition and technological change in the provision of video services. For this report we are inquiring about basic telecommunications services as defined IC 8-1-2.6-0.1, video services as defined in IC 8-1-34, and broadband connection services.

In order to fulfill this objective and complete our report in a timely manner, we request that the **IURC Communications Survey** be completed and returned to the IURC Communications Division **no later than April 6, 2008**. Surveys may be submitted in three different ways: email attachment, mailed paper copy, or as a "general submission" using the IURC's new Electronic Filing System.
